Methodology: ComRes interviewed 1,011 London adults aged 18+ online between 13<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018. Data were weighted to be demographically representative of all London adults. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
